The Genius of Jesus

We introduced our Parables season last week and begin to dig into the parables today. I've given a lot of thought to how to approach this series. At the end of the day, I feel we will be blessed to have covered the entirety of the Parables as opposed to picking and choosing a select few. This series will be a series that we will "scatter" with other series mixed in- meaning we won't finish the entirety of the series until sometime next year- but will also break off to do other series and sermons as well. Here is a working outline of what we hope to cover over the next 14-15 months.

- Parables about Grace and Responsibility (2 Parts): The Unforgiving Servant; The Two Debtors.
- Parables of Lostness (3 Parts): The Lost Sheep, The Lost Coin, The Lost Sons
 - Parable of the Sower (1-2 Parts)
- Parables about Israel (4 parts): The Barren Fig Tree, The Two Sons, The Wicked Tenants, The Wedding Feast
- Parables about The Kingdom (6 parts): The Growing Seed, The Wheat and Weeds, The Mustard Seed, The Leaven, The Treasure, The Pearl
- Parables about Discipleship (4 parts): The Builders, The Good Samaritan, The Workers in the Vineyard, The Tower Builder and the King
 - Parables about Money (3 Parts): The Rich Fool, The Unjust Steward, The Rich Man and Lazarus
- Parables about God and Prayer(3 Parts): The Friend at Midnight, The Unjust Judge, The Pharisee and Tax Collector
 - Parables about the End of Time (4 Parts): The Net, The Ten Virgins, The Talents, The Sheep and Goats

That's somewhere around 30 parts that will be scattered over roughly 60 weeks- It's likely we will not stick to the order listed above- but we will stick to the different sections listed. We will start with Parables about Discipleship this week. The outline is primarily from "Stories with Intent" by Klyne R. Snodgrass- a valuable- extremely thorough resource. I believe this format will allow us to have a complete study and also a study where we can meditate and pray over these important teachings of the Messiah both textually and topically. I hope you will pray for the series to bring out fruit in all of our lives. Daniel Courington
