Bio for Jim Harrington

Jim was born in Anniston, Alabama. He is the oldest of five children. In 1965, he met the love of his life, Nancy Carroll. Nancy introduced Jim to Jesus and on April 24, 1966, he was baptized by William B. Kughn. Bro. Kughn also performed their wedding on the Kughn's 22nd anniversary.

Biologically, Jim and Nancy have two children, Matt and Shannon. They have four grandchildren, Chris, Clint, Corey and Chloe and two great grandchildren Braxton and Kyle. By other means, they have a host of those that call them Mom and Dad, Nana and Papa.

Jim began working for a company that manufactured men's clothing in Anniston on February 1, 1971. The company transferred his family to the main office in Michigan City, Indiana in 1974. In 1980, the church in Michigan City lost its preacher and Jim filled in until a new preacher was in place. This began a fire that could not be quenched.

Jim preached for churches that could not afford full-time ministers in northern Indiana and southern Michigan for three years while maintaining his position as Distribution Manager of a large clothing company.

After thirteen years with the same company, in 1984, Jim gave up his position and moved his family to Dallas, Texas where he received his degree in Bible. Before graduating Jim became the Youth and Family Minister for the Meadow View Church of Christ in Mesquite, Texas. In 1990, he became the Preaching Minister of Meadow View and served in that capacity through 1998.

In September 1998, Jim was asked by the Greenbrier Central Church of Christ in Anniston to serve as one of its ministers. After serving the Meadow View Church of Christ for fourteen years, he began working with the Greenbrier Church of Christ on January 1, 1999 and served as one of the ministers until May 14, 2017.

Jim has been blessed by serving two great churches for thirty-three years and prays that the Lord blesses him in serving in different capacities until the Lord decides to bring him home.
